

Camp Dartmouth Hitchcock (Camp DH)

Camp DH is a one-week residential summer camp experience for children with juvenile idiopathic arthritis and other inflammatory connective tissue diseases. Since 1983, Camp DH has hosted up to 53 boys and girls a year from ages 8 to 17.

At Camp DH, campers enjoy traditional activities such as outdoor games, swimming, canoeing, and arts and crafts.

In addition, communication and problemsolving skills are challenged through a series of structured activities, such as the ropes course. Campers are encouraged by their peers and staff to confront physical challenges they believe they cannot achieve. This gives the campers a sense of accomplishment and self-confidence that they will keep with them year-round.

Families are responsible for arranging transportation for their campers to and from camp. Please plan travel accordingly. Camp DH welcomes campers from all language backgrounds. To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, basic English comprehension is necessary for communication.
